Dr. Guerra trained specifically and extensively for a career in cosmetic plastic surgery becoming a board certified in plastic surgery by The American Board of Plastic Surgery in 2003. In 2006, he chose to relocate his offices to Arizona and opened the AB Guerra Plastic Surgery Center.

Dr. Guerra has chosen to concentrate his efforts solely on cosmetic plastic surgery procedures that enhance the appearance of the human form. Although he currently concentrates on cosmetic procedures, Dr. Guerra began his career performing breast reconstruction and pediatric plastic surgery procedures. He served as Chief of Adult and Pediatric Plastic Surgery at the downtown campus for the LSU Health Sciences Center in Louisiana.
